Barbara Feiner is the Vice Chancellor for Finance and Chief Financial Officer at Washington University in St. Louis. She joined the university in 1996 as Director of Investment Management and was promoted to Chief Financial Officer the following year. She has been Vice Chancellor since April 1999.

Barb has a B.A. from St. Louis University where she majored in psychology. She taught elementary school for several years before returning to graduate school. In 1983 she received her MBA from Washington University's Olin School of Business and then spent 13 years at Edison Brothers Stores Inc., where she held a number of positions before joining the university.

Barb is involved in alumni activities of Washington University having served as president of the Olin School's alumni association and also chair of the university's Alumni Board of Governors. She serves on the Investment Committee of a local prep school and is currently the chair of the Finance Committee at her parish.
